**ORDER**

On January 28, 2016, the appellant filed pro se an informal brief appealing that part of a September 18, 2015, decision of the Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board) that remanded the issue of service connection for prostate cancer. The appellant argues that the Board denied service connection for prostate cancer and that the Board's determination should be reversed. The record reflects, however, that the Board did not deny service connection for prostate cancer and instead remanded that matter for further development. Because there is no final and adverse Board decision on the matter being appealed, the Court will dismiss the appellant's appeal. *See Hibbard v. West*, 13 Vet.App. 546, 548 (2000) (per curiam order) (Court's jurisdiction is statutorily limited to appeals of final Board decisions adverse to claimant); *see also Breedon v. Principi*, 17 Vet.App. 475, 478 (2004) (holding that the Court does not have jurisdiction over a Board remand because that determination is not a final decision); 38 C.F.R. § 20.1100(b) (2015) ("A remand is in the nature of a preliminary order and does not constitute a final decision of the Board.").

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that the appellant's appeal of that part of the September 18, 2015, Board decision that remanded the issue of service connection for prostate cancer is DISMISSED.
