ORDER

Veteran Jean Jones appeals through counsel a June 29, 2015, decision of the Board of Veterans' Appeals. The parties agree that Ms. Jones was awarded an increased rating for her right knee in 1964; however, neither the parties' record citations nor the record appear to support their agreement. *Compare* Opening Brief at 1 (stating that an increased rating was awarded in 1964 and citing Record (R.) at 1334), *and* Response Br. at 2 (same), *with* R. at 1334 (1964 rating decision noting a 10% rating for, inter alia, a right-knee disability with a July 1957 effective date), *and id.* at 1383 (1958 rating sheet awarding 10% rating for, inter alia, a right-knee disability with a July 1957 effective date).

On consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, no later than 7 days from the date of this order, the parties file a joint supplemental memorandum clarifying whether an increased rating was awarded in 1964. It is further

ORDERED that, if the parties cannot agree to a joint memorandum, the Secretary file a supplemental memorandum addressing the issue no later than 7 days from the date of this order, and Ms. Jones may file, within 7 days after the Secretary files his supplemental memorandum, a response thereto.
