**APPELLEE’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO RESPOND TO APPELLANT’S BRIEF UNTIL OCTOBER 28, 2019**

Pursuant to U.S. Vet. App. R. 26(b), 27, and 45(g), Appellee, Robert L. Wilkie, Secretary of Veterans Affairs, respectfully moves the Court for a forty-five day extension of time within which to respond to Appellant’s Brief. If not for this motion, the Secretary’s response would be due on September 13, 2019.

The request for more time is being made because of substantial workload and to obtain supervisory review. Therefore, in order to allow the undersigned counsel sufficient time to provide a thoughtful and thorough response to Appellant’s brief in this case, he respectfully requests a forty-five day extension.
