**COUNSEL'S CORRECTION OF ERRONEOUS STATEMENT AT ORAL
ARGUMENT.**

Mr. Attig files this motion to correct a statement he made in the oral argument of this matter on November 4, 2020.

At 34:24 of the oral argument recording, Chief Judge Bartley asked counsel for the Secretary if the *Nehmer* class counsel filed an amicus brief at the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit in *Williams v. Principi*, 310 F.3d 1374 (Fed. Cir. 2002).

At 48:25 of the oral argument recording, I informed the Court that NVLSP had filed an amicus brief before the Federal Circuit, and represented that the amicus asked the Court to defer decision until the appellant in *Williams v. Principi* had exhausted their administrative remedy in the *Nehmer* enforcing district court.

I was wrong; I confused the Veterans Court's *en banc* adjudication of *Williams v. Principi* with the Federal Circuit's review of the Veterans Court's

decision. NVLSP filed an amicus before the Veterans Court.¹ According to the Federal Circuit's docket sheet in *Williams v. Principi*,² NVLSP did not file an amicus brief before the Federal Circuit.³

I apologize to the Court, the Secretary, and counsel for the Secretary for my mistake. My intent was not to deceive the Court; I confused the proceedings in *Williams v. Principi* before this Court with the proceedings in *Williams v. Principi* before the Federal Circuit.
