On April 29, 2022, veteran Felix Paul Phillips appealed through counsel an April 1, 2022, decision of the Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board). On March 24, 2023, the Court issued a memorandum decision remanding, in part, the Board decision. The Secretary filed a timely motion for reconsideration or, in the alternative, for a decision by a panel of the Court. On July 5, 2023, the Court granted the motion for panel review; on July 10, 2023, the case was referred to a panel of the Court. Oral argument was held on January 10, 2024.

However, pending before the Court is the appeal of *Jackson v. McDonough*, No. 22-3528, which was submitted to a panel to consider issues that may have a direct impact on the disposition of this appeal. Accordingly, in the interest of judicial efficiency, it is

ORDERED, sua sponte, that the above-captioned appeal is stayed pending the Court's resolution of *Jackson*, or until further order of the Court.
