Pursuant to Rules 26(b) and 27, Appellant asks that the Court permit a 30 day extension of time, until April 15, 2015, in which to file Appellant’s reply to the Secretary's response to the appellant's EAJA petition. Appellant's reply is presently due Monday, March 16, 2015. The additional time is needed due to competing workload demands.

Appellant obtained a 45 day extension for filing the brief on the merits, and a 45 day extension for his reply brief on the merits, for a total of 90 days, but this is the first extension sought by Appellant in the fee portion of the case. The Secretary obtained 45 days for filing his brief on the merits and 45 days for filing his response to the EAJA petition.

The Secretary is unopposed to the granting of this motion.
