## ORDER

On July 28, 2016, the Court issued a memorandum decision vacating the Board of Veterans Appeals' April 8, 2015, decision concerning Ely R. Acosta's entitlement to a disability rating in excess of 30% for headaches for the period prior to November 1, 2009, and remanding the matter for further development.

On August 23, 2016, Mr. Acosta filed through counsel an unopposed motion to expedite issuance of mandate on the basis of the parties' consent. Mr. Acosta requests that the Court suspend the 60-day waiting period between entry of judgment and the issuance of mandate as prescribed in Rule 41 of this Court's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Given the parties' agreement, which amounts to a waiver of the remainder of time in which to file an appeal of the Court's decision, the Court will grant the motion to expedite issuance of mandate and will direct the Clerk of the Court to issue mandate as of the date of this order.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Mr. Acosta's motion to expedite issuance of mandate is GRANTED. It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court issue mandate as of the date of this order.
