APPELLEE'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR A 45-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME, UNTIL NOVEMBER 16, 2017 TO FILE THE SECRETARY'S RESPONSE TO APPELLANT'S FEE APPLICATION
