**APPELLEE’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

TO APPELLANT’S APPLICATION FOR ATTORNEY FEES AND EXPENSES
UNTIL JANUARY 17, 2019**

Pursuant to U.S. Vet.App. R. 26(b) and 45(g), Appellee, Robert L. Wilkie, Secretary of Veterans Affairs, respectfully moves the Court for a 45-day extension of time within which to file the Secretary’s response under U.S. Vet.App. R. 39(a) to Appellant’s application for attorney fees and expenses.
