ORDER

On January 28, 2020, the Court granted veteran Clifton Arline's motion for panel consideration in the above-captioned appeal. The Court subsequently scheduled oral argument for March 26, 2020.

On February 12, 2020, the Secretary filed an unopposed motion for leave to file a supplemental brief to address the issues raised in Mr. Arline's motion for panel consideration. The Court granted that motion on February 18, 2020, and the Secretary filed his supplemental brief on March 3, 2020. The next day, Mr. Arline filed a motion for leave to file a response to the Secretary's supplemental brief. He requests that the Court provide him 14 days for this filing.

The Court will grant Mr. Arline's motion to the extent that he requests leave to file a response to the Secretary's supplemental brief. However, the Court will deny the motion to the extent that Mr. Arline requests 14 days to file that response. Given the upcoming oral argument, the Court will allow Mr. Arline five days from the date of this order to file his response. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Mr. Arline's March 4, 2020, motion for leave to file a response to the Secretary's supplemental brief is granted in part and denied in part. Mr. Arline must file his response, which is not to exceed 15 pages in length, within 5 days of the date of this order.
