I said inadequate because two (ankle & neck) of the four injuries documented in the 2012 exam have been revised. So for the last ten to eleven years the VA have been minimizing my injuries and depriving me of my full medical benefits because they denied they were service connected. There's nerve problems in the lower back that have not been addressed.

CT cervical spine without contrast

Clinical Information: Fall

Procedure: CT scan images were obtained.

Findings:

Comparison 6/18/2013 CT neck

Severe degenerative changes in the spine discogenic and some facet arthropathy related. Lytic changes in the spine predominantly associated with endplates suggesting Schmorl's nodes with some in the vertebral bodies and these may be benign predominantly seen previous. Height loss involving C3 and C4 and C5 and C6 mild unchanged suggesting remote fractures. Sclerotic changes in the spine are likely degenerative and unchanged. Remaining spine unremarkable.

Mild to moderate central canal narrowing C3-4 from disc bulge. Mild to moderate multilevel other central canal narrowings from his bulges. Multilevel moderate and severe foraminal narrowings throughout the spine.

Mild heterogeneity in the thyroid. Moderate emphysema upper lungs. Pleural based 3 mm lung nodule axial image 170 left upper lobe unchanged. Mild pleural parenchymal nodular densities upper lungs likely scarring.

Impression:

Mild remote compression fractures

No acute fracture identified.

Degenerative changes.
