ORDER

On October 28, 2019, the appellant filed a Notice of Appeal. The Secretary filed a motion to stay proceedings and moved to dismiss, asserting that the appellant has failed to exhaust his administrative remedies. The Secretary reports that the Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board), in its August 5, 2019, decision, remanded the issue of whether the veteran is competent to handle the disbursement of VA funds. Under the law, this Court may review only final Board decisions which have been decided against a claimant. It is

ORDERED that the appellant show cause, within 20 days after the date of this order, why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Proceedings on this appeal are stayed until further order of the Court.
