**REVISED APPELLANT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR A 28-DAY
EXTENSION OF TIME, UNTIL FRIDAY, APRIL 24, 2020,
TO FILE APPELLANT’S BRIEF**

Pursuant to U.S. Vet. App. R. 26(b), Appellant respectfully submits this revised motion requesting a 28-day extension of time, until April 24, 2020 to file Appellant’s brief in this case. Appellant’s brief was due to be filed with the Clerk of the Court on March 27, 2020.

This is the fourth extension sought in this action. Appellant previously moved for a 30-day extension to file Appellant’s brief because the undersigned counsel was unable to reach Appellant to inform him of the Joint Motion for Remand. Prior to that, Appellant moved to reschedule the telephonic briefing conference from the originally scheduled date of January 14, 2020 until January 27, 2020 (7 days).

Prior to that, Appellant moved for an extension of time to respond to the Record Before the Agency (45 days). (Docket) That motion pre-dated the

undersigned being assigned this case by the Veterans Consortium Pro Bono Program.

This extension of time is required because counsel for the Appellant now believes the Appellant is deceased and needs additional time to confirm that and determine whether there is anyone to substitute for him in this appeal.

Counsel for the Secretary, Anna Castillo, Esq., indicated that the Secretary is **not opposed** to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that the Court grant this unopposed motion for an extension of time.
