On March 18, 2020, Robert C. Hensley petitioned the Court for extraordinary relief in the nature of a writ of mandamus. The petitioner asks the Court to compel the Jackson, Mississippi, Regional Office (RO) to issue a rating decision implementing those parts of a February 13, 2019, Board of Veterans' Appeals decision granting entitlement to service connection for a skin disorder and peripheral neuropathy of the bilateral lower extremities.


The petitioner provided evidence that he has contacted VA multiple times regarding the status of the matters. The Board replied to the petitioner on December 17, 2019, informing him that the Board had returned the claims file to the RO where the necessary development would be completed, but the petitioner has received no response from the Regional Office (RO).

Based on the facts alleged a response from the Secretary is warranted. It is

ORDERED that within 14 days of the date of this order, the Secretary shall respond and provide the Court with the status of the matters granted in the Board's February 13, 2019, decision.
