RESPONDENT'S NOTICE TO COURT

Respondent, Robert L. Wilkie, Secretary of Veterans Affairs, respectfully notifies the Court of the following matters.

Petitioner's application for extraordinary relief, in the nature of a writ of mandamus, seeks assistance from the Court regarding a Statement of the Case (SOC) that was issued in October 2017 addressing five claims, but mailed to an incorrect address, and his subsequent request for a hearing before the Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board or BVA).

Petitioner asserts that his requests for a status report regarding his hearing request have not been satisfactorily addressed.

The undersigned counsel for the Secretary established liaison with the appropriate officials at the Board, the Appeals Management Office (AMO) in Washington, DC, and the VA Regional Office (RO) in St. Petersburg, FL, who reviewed the relevant entries and documents in the VA claims files for the Petitioner.

In a VA Deferred Rating Decision, dated April 17, 2020, the RO noted that:

Veteran was issued a SOC on 10-04-17. This [was] returned for bad address on 11-02-2017, [we] did not issue the veteran another SOC. He called . . . [on] the phone . . . on 1-22-18 where he was informed of the SOC. He submitted a Form 9 on this date. Therefore, since he submitted this form 9 with[in] 60 days of his notification we have accept this as a perfected Appeal. VSCCCRIB, DRO (Ex. 1).

The Petitioner's appeal was certified to the Board on April 17, 2020. (Ex. 2).

On April 20, 2020, the Petitioner was advised that his appeal was certified to the Board and that his request for a Travel hearing would be addressed by the Board. (Ex. 3).
