On March 26, 2020, veteran Lance David Williams filed through counsel a petition for extraordinary relief in the nature of a writ of mandamus. On March 27, 2020, the Court ordered the Secretary to respond to the allegations in Mr. Williams's petition. *See* U.S. VET. APP. R. 21(d).

On April 15, 2020, prior to the Secretary filing a response, Mr. Williams filed an unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal of the petition.
