On April 3, 2020, Brian Fernandez, filed through counsel, a petition for extraordinary relief in the nature of a writ of mandamus asking the Court to compel the Roanoke Regional Office to forward a copy of the petitioner's claims file. On April 6, 2020, the Court ordered that the Secretary respond to the petitioner's allegations.

On May 5, 2020, the petitioner filed an unopposed motion asking the Court to dismiss his petition because the Secretary had provided him with a copy of his claims file. The Court will decide the petitioner's motion to dismiss in due course, but we no longer need the Secretary to respond to the petition. Thus, we will withdraw our April 6, 2020, order.

On consideration of the above, it is

ORDERED that the Court's April 6, 2020, order for the Secretary to respond is withdrawn and that these proceedings are stayed pending further order of this Court.
