On April 27, 2020, the Court issued a memorandum decision that affirmed a May 2, 2019, Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board) decision denying the self-represented appellant entitlement to benefits for bilateral knee disabilities, a right hand disability, bronchial cancer, and a traumatic brain injury, as well as a request to reopen a previously denied claim for benefits for a dental condition.¹

On May 18, 2020, the appellant filed a timely motion for reconsideration pursuant to Rule 35 of the Court's Rules of Practice and Procedure. He wrote:

- (1) I did not receive a letter on your decision—19-5066.
- (2) The [Board] made a decision without a complete record sent to the Court without the record from [19]73-74.
- (3) I hope the Court did not make the same oversight in [its] decision. If true[,] the Court should be excus[ed].

Motion for Reconsideration at 1. Based on review of the pleadings and the motion for reconsideration, the Court concludes that the appellant has not demonstrated that the Court, in issuing the single-judge memorandum decision, overlooked or misunderstood a fact or point of law that was prejudicial to the outcome of the appeal. *See* U.S. VET. APP. R. 35(e)(1).

¹ The Court also dismissed the appellant's appeal of those parts of the Board decision that denied entitlement to benefits for bilateral shoulder and elbow disabilities, neck and heart disabilities, hypertension, headaches, and a blood disorder, as well as a request to reopen a claim for benefits for an acquired psychiatric disability.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is denied.
