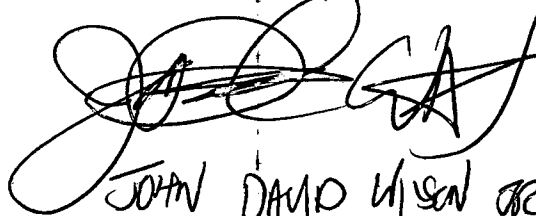

The U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims reached out to us about a recent letter you sent to the Court dated May 13, 2020. In that letter, you requested the Court dismiss your case. However, please note that just a few days before, on May 7, 2020, the Court decided your case *in your favor* and remanded the case back to the Board of Veterans Appeals. We have enclosed a copy of that decision for your convenience.

On June 3, 2020, upon receiving your letter, the Court stayed your case and asked us to reach out to you. A copy of the Court's order is also enclosed. We suggest that you contact us or the Court and withdraw your motion to dismiss since your case was remanded and the Board of Veterans Appeals will have to issue a new decision.
