ORDER

On September 18, 2020, the appellant filed his reply brief. On October 7, 2020, the Court granted *nunc pro tunc* to September 18, 2020, the appellant's unopposed motion to stay proceedings for 60 days to allow for service to be made on Mr. Leroy Brinkley, a party of the proceedings before the Board of Veterans' Appeal, and to allow him an opportunity to intervene.
