On March 24, 2021, the parties filed a joint motion for remand (JMR). As part of their motion, the parties have affirmatively waived any and all rights to appeal the Court's order on the JMR and respectfully requested the Court to enter mandate upon granting the JMR. It is

ORDERED that the JMR is granted. The Board of Veterans' Appeals February 20, 2020, decision that denied the appellant service connection for bilateral plantar fasciitis and a left and right leg condition is set aside and the matter is remanded pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7252(a) for action consistent with the terms of the JMR. *See Forcier v. Nicholson*, 19 Vet.App. 414, 425 (2006); *Stegall v. West*, 11 Vet.App. 268, 271 (1998). This order is the mandate of the Court. An application pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), for award of attorney fees and other expenses may be submitted for filing with the Clerk not later than 30 days from the date of this order.
