Appellant Juli K. Lonaker appeals a November 13, 2018, Board of Veterans' Appeals decision that denied appellant's claim for entitlement to retroactive DEA benefits. On March 22, 2021, this case was submitted to a panel for a decision. Oral argument is scheduled for June 3, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.

One of the issues being considered in this matter is whether VA was required to provide notice to appellant of her eligibility for Chapter 35 Dependents' Educational Assistance (DEA) benefits. To assist the Court in the resolution of this appeal, counsel for each party should be prepared to discuss, in addition to the other issues briefed, the import of 38 U.S.C. § 3501(b) with respect to the notice requirement set forth in 38 U.S.C. § 3563.
