Pursuant to U.S. Vet. App. R. 30(b), the Secretary hereby advises the Court of *Sears v. Principi*, 16 Vet.App. 244 (2002), which is pertinent and significant authority for the matters on appeal. Specifically, *Sears* provides an analysis of the interplay between 38 U.S.C. § 5108 and 38 U.S.C. § 5110. *See* 16 Vet.App. at 247-48. Both parties rely extensively on § 5108 and § 5110 and, indeed, the relationship between § 5108 and § 5110 is a point of contention on appeal. *See* (Appellant's Brief at 5-16; Secretary's Brief at 9-18). Thus, this case is pertinent and significant authority.
