On March 2, 2021, Charles J. Love, Jr., through counsel, petitioned for extraordinary relief in the nature of a writ of mandamus. On June 3, 2021, the Court submitted the case to a panel of Judges Meredith, Falvey, and Laurer. On June 21, 2021, the case was scheduled for oral argument on Thursday, September 9, 2021.

On July 7, 2021, counsel for the Secretary moved to reschedule oral arguments. Counsel stated that she would be unavailable September 8, 2021, through September 13, 2021, and would thus be unable to participate in oral argument during that period. Counsel for the Secretary noted that Mr. Love's counsel does not oppose the motion.
