The additional authority consists of an update to a precedential case previously issued by the Federal Circuit.

Counsel for Appellant previously notified the court of the decision in *Taylor v. McDonough*, No. 2019-2211, 2021 WL 2672307 (Fed. Cir. June 30, 2021), where a panel of the Federal Circuit held the pro-veteran canon applies at step one when interpreting a statute. On July 22, 2021, the Federal Circuit vacated the June 30, 2021 decision in *Taylor*, and reinstated the appeal.
