The Court ordered this case to panel on August 24, 2021, and scheduled oral argument for October 5, 2021. The appellant filed an unopposed motion to postpone and reschedule oral argument to either the week beginning October 18 or 25, 2021. Because the Court cannot schedule arguments for the period requested, we deny the motion.

However, if counsel cannot conduct arguments on the date currently scheduled, she has until September 24, 2021, to bring a new motion to reschedule arguments. If the appellant renews the motion, she is advised that the oral arguments will likely be postponed until December 2021 or January 2022.

ORDERED that the appellant's motion to postpone and reschedule oral argument is DENIED.
