**APPELLEE’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION OF ISSUES
FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**

On July 14, 2022, the Court ordered the parties to present oral argument on October 6, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. On appeal are the parts of a July 23, 2020, Board of Veterans’ Appeals (Board) decision that denied entitlement to: (1) a rating greater than 20% for a right shoulder disability; (2) a rating greater than 20% for a left knee disability; and (3) a rating greater than 10% for a skin disability before February 8, 2016.

The parties’ briefing included arguments regarding all three issues on appeal. As such, clarification of the issue, or issues, of interest to the Court would aid the parties in preparing for oral argument. Clarification of the issues would also assist the Court by ensuring the parties are prepared to address the discrete issue, or issues, the Court wishes to examine at oral argument.
