ORDER

Appellant Tina L. Lockett appeals a June 10, 2021, Board of Veterans' Appeals decision that denied entitlement to a compensable disability rating for recurrent vulvovaginitis.¹ This matter was submitted to panel on September 22, 2022, and oral argument was scheduled for January 10, 2023.

The parties subsequently filed a joint motion for partial remand (JMPR), agreeing that the Board provided an inadequate statement of reasons or bases for its decision.² The parties also agree to "unequivocally waive" any right to appeal the Court order,³ and the parties ask the Court to issue mandate upon the issuance of an order granting the JMPR.⁴ The Court will grant the parties' motion.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the October 4, 2022, order scheduling oral argument for January 10, 2023, is revoked. It is further

ORDERED that the December 28, 2022, JMPR is granted. It is further
