ORDER

Veteran Michael Webb, through counsel, appeals an August 13, 2021, Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board) decision that denied entitlement to a disability evaluation higher than 20% for ulnar and median neuropathy of the left hand prior to October 15, 2014. Record at 5-13. This matter was submitted to panel on March 17, 2023, and oral argument was scheduled for October 11, 2023.

On October 6, 2023, the parties filed a joint motion to terminate (JMT) the appeal with prejudice, JMT at 1-3, along with a stipulated agreement, *id.* at 4-6. The parties agree to "unequivocally waive" further Court review and any right to appeal the Court's order, and they ask the Court to issue mandate upon the issuance of an order granting the JMT. *Id.* at 2. The Court will grant the parties' motion.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the May 25, 2023, order scheduling oral argument for October 11, 2023, is revoked. It is further

ORDERED that the parties' JMT is granted and that the appeal of the August 13, 2021, Board decision is TERMINATED with prejudice. It is further

ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 41(c)(2) of the Court's Rules of Practice and Procedure, that this order is the mandate of the Court.
