**APPELLEE’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME UNTIL  
DECEMBER 14, 2023, TO FILE APPELLEE’S RESPONSE TO APPELLANT’S  
APPLICATION FOR FEES UNDER THE EQUAL ACCESS TO JUSTICE ACT**

Pursuant to U.S. Vet. App. R. 26(b), Appellee, Denis McDonough, Secretary of Veterans Affairs (Secretary), respectfully requests a 45-day extension of time within which to file the Secretary’s Response to Appellant’s Application for fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA) in the above-captioned case, which is due on or before October 30, 2023.
