**RESPONDENT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF
TIME TO RESPOND TO PETITIONER’S APPLICATION FOR
ATTORNEYS’ FEES UNDER EAJA UNTIL DECEMBER 11, 2023**

Pursuant to U.S. Vet. App. R. 26(b), Respondent, Denis McDonough, Secretary of Veterans Affairs, respectfully moves the Court for a 30-day extension of time within which to respond to Petitioner’s Application for Attorneys’ Fees Under EAJA. If not for this motion, the Secretary’s response would be due on November 19, 2023.

The request for more time is being made because of the undersigned’s current deadlines and workload considerations in other cases pending before the Court. Petitioner is not opposed to this motion.

Neither party has previously been granted any days of extension in the EAJA stage of this case thus far. On behalf of the Secretary, counsel expresses regret to the Court and Petitioner for any inconvenience caused by the delay in filing the Secretary’s response. However, in view of the

aforesaid circumstances, an extension of 30 days, until December 11, 2022, is requested.
