

Father, son bikers killed in head-on crash in NSB, driver seriously injured

The motorcyclists were on State Road 415 when a car trying to pass crashed into them, the FHP said.

A father-and-son pair of motorcyclists from Deltona were killed late Tuesday and a driver suffered serious injuries when she tried to pass a pickup and collided head on with the two motorcycles, according to the Florida Highway Patrol.

Eric Johnson, 54, was riding a 2008 Kawasaki motorcycle and his son, Jaramis Johnson, 27, was riding another Kawasaki when they were killed in the crash at 10:25 p.m. on State Road 415 and La Starza Drive, the FHP said.

Kaily Blankenship, 20, of Edgewater suffered serious injuries and was taken to Halifax Health Medical Center in Daytona Beach.

Blankenship was driving north in her 1998 Honda 2-two door car when she tried to pass in a passing zone a Dodge pickup driven by Kristijan Lasic, 17, of Port Orange.

The front of Blankenship's car crashed with the two motorcycles and then her car struck the pickup, the FHP said.

Lasic was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation and charges are pending against Blankenship.




